Left C. Guzman, westward approx. 10 mi; To lower edge of pine at Foot of Mt. in Pine for Smij; to Foot of main slope (6500') at ranch. 2 nights, ascended Mt by steep mule trail to 12,000'; + from this camp; worked up to 13500'. Descended to C. Guzman; + returned more westerly route; stopping Fir 2 nights at 5000 + 6500; 3rd night camped at 10,000' near Spring; + next day descended to small spring in canyon at 7500'. Limited obser. indicated principal timber belts on north slope are: Lower pine belt from 5000-6500'; oak belt 6500 to 8500-9000'; + upper pine & Fir belt from 9000-12500'; above 12500'; Alpine belt was dense stand of grass 2-4' high. Trip was made April 9-13, 20-23, 1892.
