

About 5% of Title I Districts to Receive Almost 90% of the \$700 (May Be \$860) Million Title I Funding Increase Next School Year

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About 250 districts will be receiving large increases in their Title I funding, ranging from \$19 million down to approximately \$420,000. Approximately 275 districts had funding increases of 40% or more with the increase being \$100,000 or more. If the proposed \$160 million FY 2001 “supplement” is passed, the total amount of funds could be over \$860 million. These priority districts are located primarily in the states which received the largest increases in concentration funds. The reason for targeting these states is that, in most cases, the largest portion of district Title I increases are in concentration grants -- which were “unexpected.” For districts receiving concentration grants for the first time (about 130 districts), the number of students to be served next year will increase only slightly resulting in a significant increase in the amount of Title I funding per Title I students served. In some districts receiving large concentration increases, new Title I programs will be established in schools not previously served.

The reason why districts were not aware of, and did not expect to receive, increased concentration funding stems from several factors. A new provision and formula which reduces the “hold harmless” effect that has been in place since 1995 for concentration funds, will now take money away from districts which no longer qualify for concentration funds but have been receiving funding in the past because of hold harmless; those funds will be reallocated to districts which should have been receiving funds but did not. The new use of the 1997 census differs from some of the types of poverty data used by states or districts in estimating their probable increases or decreases. In some states, the SEA will be making adjustments and may have to reallocate a portion of a district’s concentration funds to the basic grants. However, at the most,

this will result in a reduction of no more than 5%-8% of the overall increase. The states receiving large percentage increases in concentration funds for next year are Alaska, California, D.C., Florida, Georgia, Hawaii, Maryland, Montana, Nevada, New York, South Carolina, North Carolina, and Virginia. Districts in states with a 10% or greater increase in basic grants are likely to establish Title I programs in additional schools which have the highest enrollments of Title I-eligible students. These states include: Connecticut (17.6% increase); Idaho (10.7% increase); Massachusetts (17.4%); New Jersey (17.4%). Many districts in these states represent potential for schoolwide purchases using not only new Title I funds, but also increases in other funds as described below, such as Class Size Reduction (to be used for training), E-Rate refunds (which can be used for software and staff development, and telecommunication costs), among others.

The specific funding sources to target within these districts are funds that would have been “carried over” if the increases had not occurred. In many districts, the Title I Director will have requested, in March-April, that between 5% and 15% of the funds allocated last year to various Title I schools not be spent and be returned to the Title I central office “reserve fund.” These funds are typically used for district-wide or Title I-wide services such as staff development or distance learning activities to benefit all students and teachers, or allocated to schools that have been recently designated to be “targeted for improvement.” These are referred to as “schools identified for improvement” under Title I or “poor performing” schools under state accountability systems. These “would-have-been carry-over-funds” will likely be expended between June (or whenever the district is officially notified of the increase by the state, which could be as late as August) and September 30.

Because of “advanced funding” for Title I and IDEA, districts will be receiving, at the earliest in July/August, only 25% of next year’s allocations, with the remainder coming toward the end of October or November after the 2002 budget is passed. This will create problems in states such as North Carolina causing certain districts which are receiving increases to be confronted with “cash flow” problems; hence, in some districts, the carry over funds would be allocated to next year’s program but be expended early during the school year primarily for staff salaries.

There are about 500 districts with large absolute increases (Exhibit 2) and/or with 40% or greater increases of at least \$100,000 (Exhibit 3). Mailings Clearinghouse is updating our “TURNKEY Hot Title I Schoolwide List” (which already includes many of these districts) by adding those districts not already included and should have such lists available with the names (including phone numbers, addresses, etc.) of the district Title I directors and principals of schoolwide programs in those districts by June 30. Also available (for \$125 per thousand) is a list of principals of Title I schoolwide programs in these key districts.
