Before you use pesticides . . .

- IDENTIFY the PEST.
- READ LABELS at the store so you can PICK the RIGHT pesticide to kill the pest.
- LEARN PRECAUTIONS before opening.
- HAVE needed PROTECTIVE CLOTHING.
- BUY all EQUIPMENT in advance.
- CLEAR THE AREA of children.
- MOVE PETS out of the area and cover PET HOUSING and supplies.
- PUT OUT all TRASH FIRES.
- READ THE LABEL, AGAIN.
- MIX the chemicals OUT IN THE OPEN.

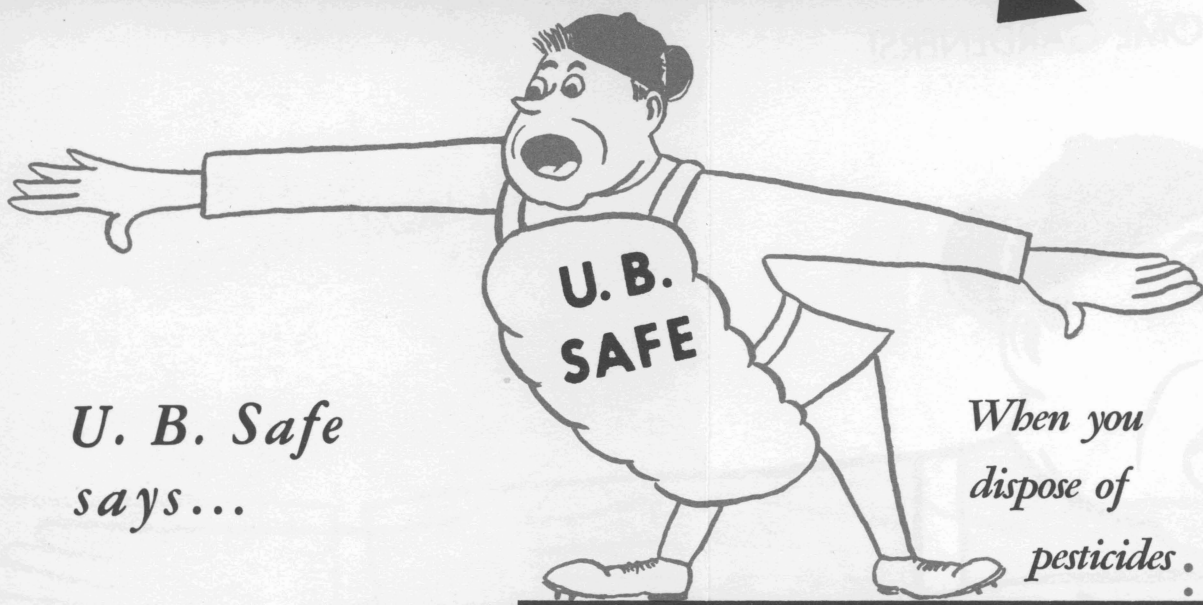
When you use pesticides . . .

- KNOW WHAT THE LABEL MEANS each time you use the product.
- DO NOT SMOKE.
- USE ONLY the AMOUNT CALLED FOR.
- NEVER dust or spray ON A WINDY DAY. Protect your neighbor.
- KEEP CHILDREN AND PETS AWAY.
- INSIDE THE HOUSE: BE CAREFUL around food, children, pets and all eating utensils. PROVIDE ADEQUATE VENTILATION.
- WHEN FINISHED: CHANGE CLOTHES and TAKE BATH or SHOWER.
- IN CASE OF ACCIDENT: DON'T PANIC. Refer to label and call Doctor for advice or treatment.

When you store pesticides . . .

- LOCK THEM UP in a cabinet, closet or tool shed. A STURDY LOCK is your BEST BUY.
- KEEP products IN THE SAME CONTAINER WITH the ORIGINAL LABEL.
- KEEP products AWAY FROM FLAMES, EXCESSIVE HEAT and MOISTURE.
- CLEAN EQUIPMENT BEFORE STORAGE.
- PROVIDE a PLACE for REFERENCES ON PROPER USE.
- KEEP the PESTICIDE DOOR LOCKED.

the best weapon you have in your garden, lawn and home . . . as you battle with bugs, weeds, rodents and other pests.

Pesticide products are your scientific weapons . . . use them . . . but, use them with care.

It's up to YOU to READ, UNDERSTAND and FOLLOW the directions on the label.

IT IS BEST TO DIG A PIT . . . 18 inches deep in an isolated area . . . POUR in UNWANTED pesticides and then COVER with 12 to 18 inches of soil.

WRAP "empty" pesticide containers in newspaper . . . then BREAK them so they can't be used again . . . and place the package in the garbage can.

Place ALL AEROSOL cans INTO the GARBAGE CAN.

CLOSE LID of garbage can TIGHTLY.
