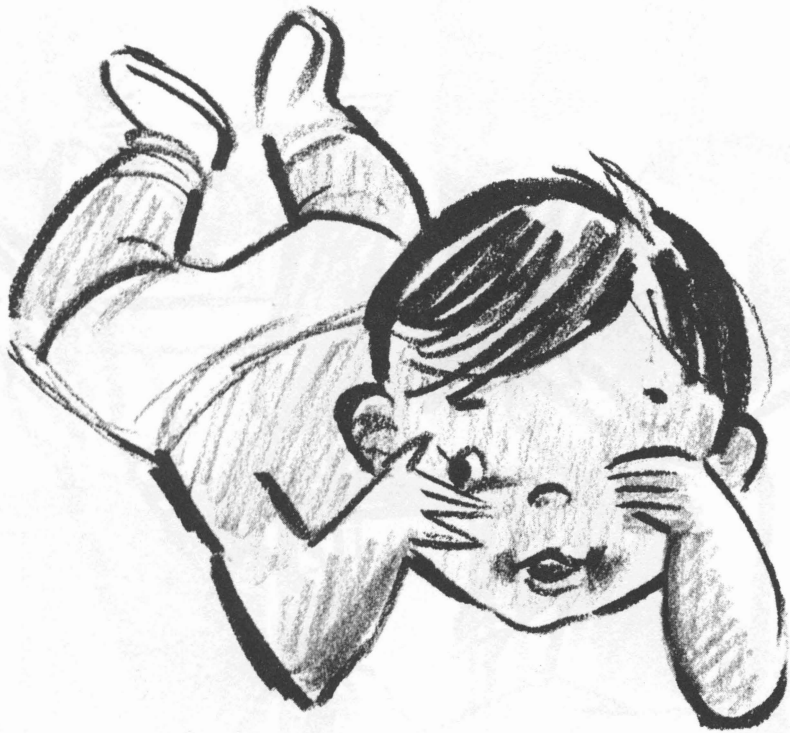
Babies want to learn

See the dog

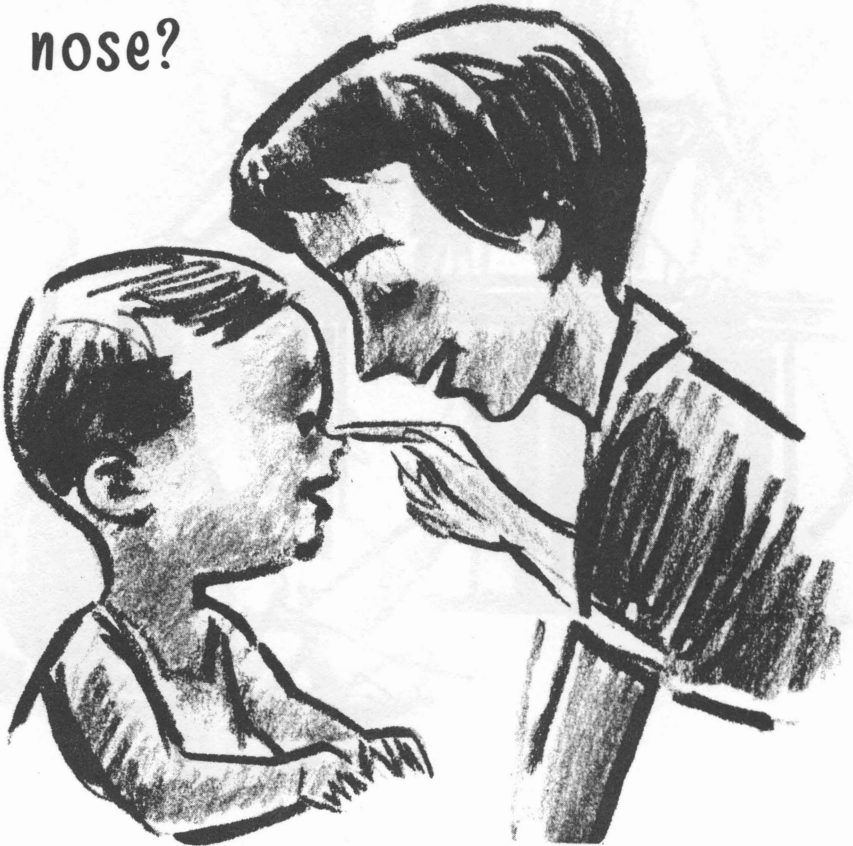
