From the editor

One of the critical junctures in the life of a Black studies program is the review process. In general, the review of a Black studies program usually involves the very survival of the program. In most academic reviews, the questions is what kind of program does the institution want to have, and how can it achieve quality of national importance, whereas when Black studies is reviewed the issue is usually whether it is causing any problems.

At the heart of this double standard is the institutional conservatism of the university that is totally inhospitable to the task of Black studies: Academic Excellence and Social Responsibility. Scholarship designed to support the status quo is regarded as fundable and "objective" whereas scholarship for social change is unacceptable and subjective. Whenever Black studies has been reviewed this contradiction has been faced.

The Black scholar, interms of Black intellectual tradition is committed to social change, the liberation of Black people. This is a universal commitment. Further, there is great respect for and mastery of methods and techniques of analysis. This places Black Studies at a crossroads: will it follow the current standards of scholarship and conform to the prevailing norms in order to survive, or will it follow the models of DuBois, Horace Mann Bond, E. Franklin Frazier, and a host of others in being scholars for social change and face bad reviews, job loss, and deteriorating relationships with less committed colleagues.
