The monies paid by the franchisee to the franchiser are known as royalties, which is a term used in such diverse industries as the entertainment industry and the fast-food industry. Fun fact: the term "royalties" hearkens back to medieval times when a king was paid back a percentage for giving someone the right of ownership or the privilege of carrying out a duty within a community that was profitable in some way.

Nowadays, there are so many different franchises it is sometimes difficult to think of them as being small businesses. The success rate of small businesses within the first several years is sadly low. When considering the success or failure of a franchise many factors are looked at, including management and leadership style which are two different things. John C. Cary, in his July 2020 *Journal of Leadership, Accountability & Ethics* article, discusses the correlation between franchise leadership and success.
