As you may have noticed, things are changing on the grounds around the BLCC. The bike racks have been moved and fencing is going up in preparation for upcoming construction of the Business Education Complex (BEC). Groundbreaking is scheduled for October 28 and the building project is expected to be completed by the end of Fall 2024, in time for Spring 2025 classes.

The newly constructed BEC will be a four-story, 82,000 square-foot building. An area adjacent to the Business Library, dubbed the "Collaboration Plaza" will serve as a connection between the two Business School buildings and the Business Library. The new facility will include electronically wired huddle and collaboration spaces as well as a café on the first floor.
