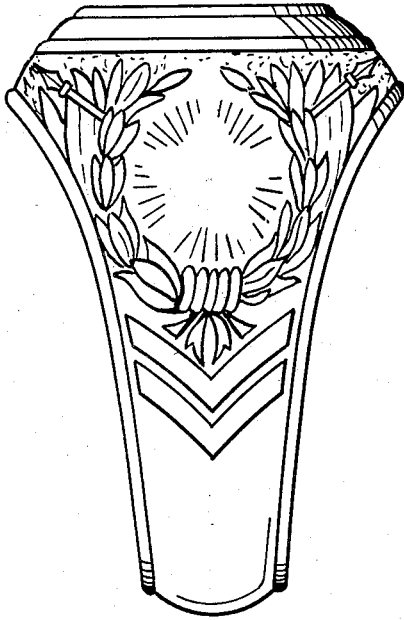

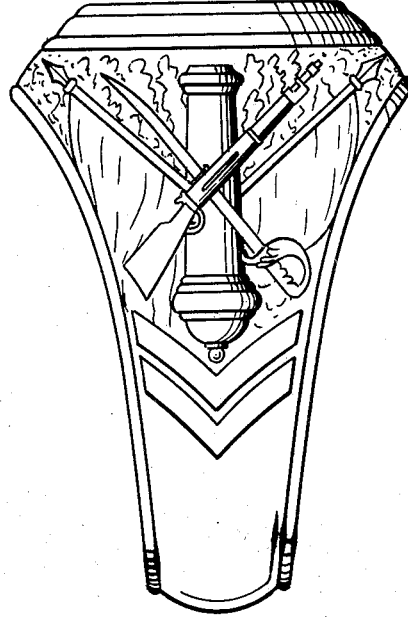

DESIGN FOR A FINGER RING

John Boehme, Houston, Tex., assignor to Star Engraving Company, Houston, Tex., a corporation of Texas

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, John Boehme, a citizen of the Republic of Germany, residing at Houston, in the county of Harris and State of Texas, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Finger Ring, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof:

Fig. 1 is a side view of the ring embodying the design. Fig. 2 is a side view taken from the opposite side from that shown in Fig. 1, and Fig. 3 is a top plan view of the ring setting shown in Figs. 1 and 2.
