## List of Districts Receiving Large Increase in Title I Funds Under FY 2002 Budget

The availability of new Title I funds and new mandates placed upon certain types of schools (e.g., targeted schools and those under corrective action) suggest that the following types of districts should be considered high priority targets over the next few months. Under the new formula, the major beneficiaries of funding increases will be large districts which have high rates of poverty. Estimated increases for many of these large districts are included in Appendix A. The Congressional Research Service estimates between 4,000 and 5,000 schools in these districts which were eligible but not funded under Title I will for the first time receive Title I funding. The district and/or new Title I schools will be purchasing products and services as part of the startup process beginning in the Spring and running through the Fall 2002.

Last year, more than 100 districts received total increases of 40 percent or more (and at least \$100,000) as they became eligible for the first time for Concentration Grants. Many of these districts were unaware they would receive these new Concentration funds under the revised Title I formula. Once these districts received their notifications, many spent "would-have-been-carry-over" funds in June 2001. However, these districts received only 17 percent of their Basic Grant allocation in July with the remainder -- including all of the new Concentration funds -- not being received until October-November. Given the lateness of such funds, most of these districts decided to allocate the Concentration funds to existing Title I schools, thereby increasing the per-pupil allocation in these schools for SY 2001-02. However, some of these districts have since decided to establish Title I programs in new schools for this coming school year; these new Title I schools should also be

targeted. Also, districts receiving Concentration funds under the new law are guaranteed to receive at least the same amount through 2005 and are good prospects for multi-year purchases. These districts are identified in Appendix B.

The next priority are those schools which have been targeted for improvement for three years; these schools will be required to provide alternative "supplemental services" as requested by parents of the lowest-achieving students. The Congressional Research Service estimates that about 3,000 such schools across the country would fall into this category.

The next of priority targets should be schoolwide programs, including those that are newly designated. The major reasons include:

- two years ago, USED reported that high-poverty schools were purchasing 2.5 new computers for every one computer purchased by low-poverty schools; schoolwide programs have 40 percent or greater poverty rates;
- Title I and other funds -- including IDEA funds -- can be commingled thereby providing a critical mass of funding for purchasing high-ticket items, and use of funds does not have to be accounted for separately under the new Law;
- schoolwide programs are more likely than "targeted assistance" schools to have applied for and received E-Rate discounts; or, more importantly, generated savings or refunds which can be used to purchase software, staff development, and computers; and
- recent findings in a report by the Education Trust found that almost 50 percent of the high-poverty, high-minority schools in the country which performed at the top third level, were Title I schoolwide programs, which suggests that they could serve as good reference sites.
