SELL ONLY RIPE TURKEYS

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Now is the Time to Start Finishing Turkeys for the Market




- ★ Treat all birds for intestinal parasites before placing them on a full feed.
- ★ Provide a limited range for feeding—Shade is necessary.
- ★ Use a good home mixed or commercial finishing mash. Put feed in open hoppers.
- ★ Allow turkeys free access to home produced grains and field peas.
- ★ Remember: wet mashes help. Give one feeding in forenoon and one in afternoon. Allow only what they will clean up in 30 minutes.
- ★ NEVER allow wet mash to remain in troughs and sour.
- ★ NEVER allow turkey to go without water even for a short period.

ONLY FINISHED TURKEYS DRESS OUT WELL

- ★ Well-finished turkeys are fat.
- ★ Well-finished turkeys are free of pin feathers.
- ★ Well-finished turkeys have eye appeal to the consumer.
- ★ Well-finished turkeys bring more money.
