#### SUPPLY

#### FAVORABLE

- I. Record supply of feed grains and concentrates.
- 2. Hay supplies, pasture conditions favor continued high production.
- 3. Dairy equipment, supplies and building materials ample.

#### DEMAND

#### FAVORABLE

- I. Per capita use of milk and cream above prewar.
- 2. U. S. population increasing steadily; Texas' up about 100,000 last year.
- 3. Increased variety of dairy products on the market.

#### UNFAVORABLE

- 1. Production costs declining more slowly than prices of dairy products.
- 2. Many Texas herds are low producers.
- 3. Dairy product feed price ratio less favorable.

#### UNFAVORABLE

- I. Consumer incomes likely lower for 1950.
- 2. Competition for consumers' dollar increasing as costs of housing, clothing remain high.
- 3. Increasing competition from other foods expected.

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
