Mohammed Mubarak - new QFIS research librarian, Faisal is a new assistant librarian

## **VCUQatar**

New library space, about 5 times larger will double the collection, includes study and comfort seating, just inside the new entrance (facing north where the old parking used to be.) Recruitment underway for library director with the idea that the candidate will be in place by January. Also hiring for evening and a part-time literacy instructor. Tammy Moe will be shifting to 50% NPRP grant and 50% Qatar Museum Authority. Nancy Fawley will be appointed interim library director.

# Central Library

No news regarding director or recruitment. Building tender bids are under evaluation (3-4 months.) Contract for III Millennium system completed, but hardware not acquired. Have a website, logo under development. Mid-December will host Arab group meeting for world digital library WDL, 20-30 countries have been invited. Large atlases have been delivered. No info on EC University, in terms of how CL fits into that entity. Will start working on acquiring electronic resources, might offer virtual reference at some point, and are asking for reference librarian positions to do reference, probably in 2011.

## WCMCQL

New information services librarian Paul Mussleman. Still have one vacancy under recruitment. Emerging interest by faculty and administration to collect regional materials in medicine in English and possibly Arabic. Interested in knowing other Arabic materials collection development policies. GUQ has a policy – about 10% Arabic, QFIS has about 90% Arabic holdings. GUQL has purchased collection holdings for the Bioethics project. Ellen will be editor-in-chief of the perspectives in international librarianship to be launched in mid-December by Bloomsbury QScience e-journal project (Arend Kuster.) Have some contributions by IFLA leaders. Needs more contributions. Submission and review software interface is being deployed.

## **TAMUQL**

New research librarian Adam Cath. Will be requesting RFID implementation for 2011 budget.

## **NUQL**

Big student event upcoming to promote library. New website (temporary) but very different. To find info on NUQL, click on left, then right for NUQ catalog. More permanent website will launch in November. Current physical library space is being evaluated; will request remodeling, especially for holdings and stacks. Arabic collection development policy being created in response to faculty request; will be purchasing and collecting in those areas.

#### **SIDRA**

Mostly lit searching, doc delivery some literacy training. Will be both clinical and a patient library, when hospital is open. All library design is complete; staff will be hired during commissioning phase.

## **Qatar Academy**

No staff changes this year. Has a large school library Arabic collection. Changed ILS from Alice to Destiny. Not all records and holdings have migrated properly, especially Arabic holdings. Will be implementing asset management. Will be proposing to combine the early childhood and primary school libraries. Will be hosting 2012 international school library conference. Hoping QISL (Qatar International School Libraries) SIG group will be the significant stakeholders and that there will be a large Arabic stream.

# Qatar Music Academy

Will have the mission to become a world class music school. Will be moving to a temp (5 year) location in Dec. Permanent, purpose-built building will be in Cultural Village (near InterContinental Hotel.) Will be opening a prep program 40 students grades 3 and 4. Also, planning an outreach program for older students and young adults. Regular program will start next September 2011 for 40-60 students. Library under development in the coming months, to acquire furniture and shelving, etc. Collection will be

everything except teaching resources, but will support a broad school library curriculum with a concentration on music. (Eventually, there may be a music research library.)

#### **TLCS**

Now housing media and library materials; lots of physical changes. Refocusing and looking at integrating technology. Will be teaching library skills right away. Almost all high school staff are new this semester. TLCS will increase student enrollment to 500 after the center moves to its new building.

GUQL will remain in LAS with other student support units until end of Fall semester, but other admin units have/are moving into new building. Staffing includes librarian and part-time position (under recruitment) to work on the bioethics grant from NPRP to include Arabic, Farsi materials in the main campus Kennedy Institute ethics website. Are working on some new library positions to be recruited for larger library in new building.

HEC (French university) will be joining EC to offer an executive MBA. Offices in LAS but classes offered downtown. (AG)
