CMUQ:

- Considering ProQuest's Research Companion for IL course next year; anyone else using it?
- TMac is a solo librarian in January, February, and March 2015.

GUSFSQ:

- 10 year anniversary for GUSFSQ. 3-4 February conference, *Scapes of Power*.
- Liz Graham chaired the steering committee and organized this year's MENA-IUG conference and workshops in Dubai for III systems users.

QA:

QA-Sidra:

- K3 through Grade 9; now including International Baccalaureate (IB). 375 students.
- New administration this year; very supportive of library.
- Maybe moving to a new/temporary building as they expand to accommodate children of Sidra employees, including Grade 10.
- 35% QF budget reduction; 21 staff members will not have contracts renewed. Arabic-language librarian not renewing; but may have an opening for an English-language librarian.
- Author visit through Qatar Reads.
- QNL registration for 60 teachers. School-wide access code for under-18s.
- Golf course is coming along (on site of school now!).

QNL:

- Lots of registrations at QF research conference.

Sidra:

- Library website/catalog (Encore) not yet launched to users. Using EBSCO discovery service; consulting with QNL.

TAMUQ:

- Faculty contracts now open to choice of 9-month or 12-month; variation is on accrual of leave. Not sure how this will impact hiring of new librarians.
- Two new library staff positions advertised.
- Website redevelopment coming soon (from main campus).

 - Language Center launched English for Specific Purposes and Chinese programs
 - Delivered 6-week curriculum-integrated information literacy program
 - Libguides used to deliver library resource information and library research skills' program

 - 35 Master's students enrolled in Translation Studies and Audiovisual Translation
 - 302 language program students

 - Temporary library assistant position vacated and position frozen
 - Librarian resigned-position advertised on TII Website
